Michelle offered to ask the same man who was the auctioneer last year if he would be willing to do it again. Sarah offered to reserve the Sherriff's complex for the workshop. Sarah explained that there have been some donations such as sewing supplies that are at the office and asked if someone would like to sort through those or if she can do it at her discretion. The committee decided that Sarah could sort through what was donated and then let people know what is available for their projects.
