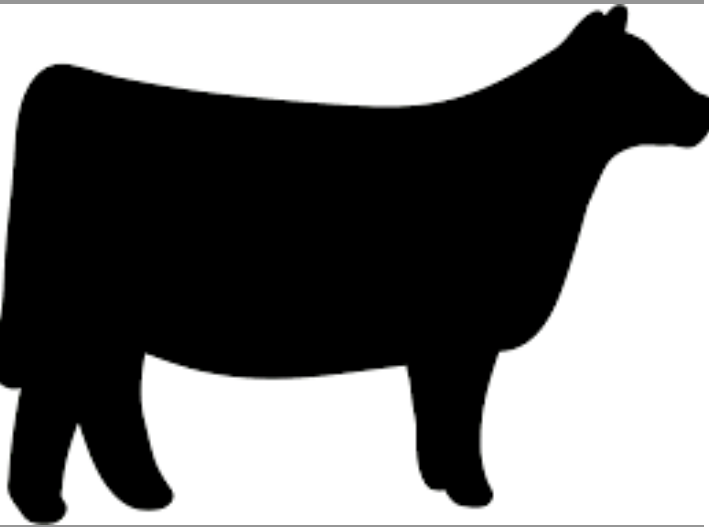

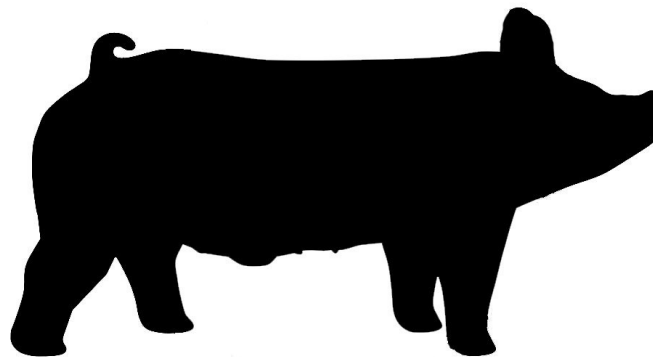
## BUILDS SKILLS
